ORAL ORDER

This writ petition is filed seeking the following prayer:

"a. Issue a writ in the nature of order or direction or certiorari quashing the impugned notice dated 29.01.2026 issued by Respondent No.1 vides Annexure-A in the interest of Justice and equity.

b. Issue a writ in nature of mandamus directing the Respondents to provide 9 months time to complete the due of Rs.2,21,91,461 in the interest of Justice.

c. Pass such other orders as this Hon'ble Court deems fit in the facts and circumstances of the case, including costs in the interest of justice and equity."

2. When this matter came up on the last occasion learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that if reasonable time is granted, the petitioner is ready to pay the entire amount. Then this Court has directed the petitioner to file an undertaking affidavit. Now the affidavit is filed. As per the affidavit it is stated that the outstanding amount of Rs.50,00,000/- will be paid on 24.03.2026; Rs.50,00,000/- will be paid on 24.05.2026, Rs.50,00,000/- will be paid on 24.06.2026 and the remaining Rs.91,44,141/- will be paid on or before 30.08.2026.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that, the petitioner now sought for about seven months to pay the entire amount and this Court may direct the petitioner to pay the entire arrears within a period of three months considering the fact that



the outstanding amount is more than Rs. 2,42,00,000/- and the petitioner has filed an undertaking before this court, balancing the interest of the Bank as well as the petitioner, this Court is passing the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The petitioner shall deposit the outstanding amount of Rs.50,00,000/- on 24.03.2026; Rs.50,00,000/- on 24.05.2026, Rs.50,00,000/- on 24.06.2026 and the remaining Rs.91,44,141/- on or before 30.08.2026.
- (ii) If the petitioner fails to pay even one installment as undertaken before the court, the respondents are at liberty to continue the proceedings pending as on today.
- (iii) Accordingly, the writ petition is ***disposed off.***
- (iv) All pending IAs in this petition shall stand closed.
