***"a) Issue a writ in the nature of mandamus directing
the respondent no.1, 2 and 3 authority to consider the
representations, dated 03.02.2026 vide Annexure-C, D
and E respectively in the interest of justice and equity.***

***b) Pass any other order as this Hon'ble Court deems
fits on the facts and circumstances of the case."***

2. It is the case of the petitioner that they have given a
representation dated 03.02.2026 to the respondent No.1 to allot
a land for establishment of a school and the same is pending
consideration.

3. The learned AGA, who accepts notice on behalf of the
respondents, submits that they will consider the representation
in accordance with law.

after hearing the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, ,
