It is submitted on behalf of the respondent that the appeal could be disposed of as having become infructuous because the appellants have handed over vacant possession of the subject property in the execution levied by the respondent.

Therefore, the appeal is adjourned to be called on **17.04.2026** observing that if there is continued absence on behalf of the appellants, the appeal could be disposed of as having become infructuous.
