Murthy, the learned Senior Counsel for the appellant, submits that, apart from other grounds, this Court must consider whether there could be any Government intervention in the matters involving service conditions of employees in un-aided private minority institutions in the light of the decision of the Apex Court in ***T.M.A. PAI Foundation Vs. State of Karnataka***¹, and
