THIS CRIMINAL REVISION PETITION IS FILED U/S 397 R/W 401 OF CR.P.c., SEEKING TO CALL FOR RECORDS AND SET ASIDE THE JUDGMENT AND ORDER PASSED BY PRINCIPAL DISTRICT AND SESSION JUDGE, DHARWAD IN CRIMINAL APPEAL NO.125/2019 DATED 01/02/2021 WHICH REJECTED THE APPEAL AND CONFIRMED THE SENTENCE AND ORDER OF CONVICTION PASSED IN C.C.NO.42/2019 PASSED BY PRL.
