THIS WRIT PETITION IS FILED UNDER ARTICLES 226 AND 227 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA, PRAYING TO (1) ISSUE A WRIT OF CERTIORARI AND QUASH THE IMPUGNED AUCTION NOTIFICATION IN DAILY NEWS PAPERS VIJAYA KARNATAKA DATED 03-07-2025 VIDE ANNEXURE-B IN THE INTEREST OF JUSTICE AND EQUITY, IN SO FAR AS PETITIONER IS CONCERNED. ORAL ORDER

The learned counsel for petitioner submits that the auction scheduled to be held in terms of auction notice dated 27.06.2025 (Annexure-B to the writ petition) has been cancelled.

2. The present writ petition having been filed to quash the said auction notification dated 03.07.2025, having regard to the subsequent events as noticed above, the relief sought for in the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous. However, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to file a fresh petition if cause arises.

3. In view of the aforementioned, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

4. This order will not preclude the petitioner from availing appropriate remedies as may be permissible under law.



5. In view of disposal of the petition, pending interlocutory applications, if any, do not survive for consideration and are disposed of accordingly.
