ORAL ORDER

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that application at I.A.No.2/2026 is filed to recall the order dated 24.02.2026 dismissing the petition for non-prosecution. I.A.No.1/2026 is filed to condone the delay of 152 days in filing the recalling application.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents would submit that the matter is remanded by the Apex Court wherein the order passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court was called in question and the order passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court is set aside and matter is remitted to this Court to hear the case afresh on merits.

3. It is the further submission of the learned counsel appearing for the respondents that earlier Special Court had passed an order attaching certain moveable and immoveable properties of the petitioner and some of them have been disposed of after the disposal of the present Writ Petition by this Court.

4. Learned counsel would submit that the petitioner be put to terms and be directed to produce the list of moveable and immoveable properties which were attached earlier by the Trial Court.

5. The Court finds merit in the submission of the learned counsel.

6. The petitioner shall furnish the list of moveable and immoveable properties which were attached earlier by the Trial Court and also shall file a declaration as to which of those properties are transferred and which are the properties still remaining.

7. In addition, the petitioner shall also furnish the list of properties which can be attached in view of the fact that some of the properties have been disposed of.

8. Awaiting compliance, list this matter on 08.09.2026.

9. In the meantime, I.A.No.1 and 2 of 2026 are allowed. The order dated 24.02.2026 is recalled. The petition is restored to file by condoning the delay of 152 days in filing the application.

10. It is made clear that there is no stay for the investigation.
