Sri Ningangouda s/o Chandanagouda is the respondent No. 4 in Writ Appeal No.100316/2021 and the appellant in Writ Appeal No.100385/2023. The appellant in Writ Appeal No.100316/2021 has filed the present set of applications [*I.A.No.1 to I.A.No.3 of 2026*] to bring the legal representatives on record, and the legal representatives themselves filed applications [*in I.A.No.1 to I.A.No.3 of 2026*] in Writ Appeal No.100385/2023, which is filed by the deceased. There is no dispute about the relationship of the deceased with the applicants-the proposed respondents. The

reasons for seeking condonation in making the request in time, is found *bonafide*.
