ORAL ORDER

This contempt petition is filed alleging non-
compliance of the order dated 04.09.2025 passed by the
learned Single Judge of this Court in
W.P.No.202655/2025.



2. The complainant had filed W.P.No.202655/2025 for a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash an endorsement dated 06.07.2024, refusing to consider his request for deletion of entries made in column No.11 of the Record of Rights relating to Sy.No.66/*/3 of Haladkeri (K) village and also for a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent Nos.2 to 4 to consider his grievance by considering his representations.

3. The writ petition was disposed of in terms of an order dated 04.09.2025 quashing the endorsement dated 06.07.2024 and directing respondent Nos.2 to 4 therein to consider the representation submitted by the complainant and remove the endorsement relating to non-alienation in respect of the petitioner's land within a period of four weeks.

4. The complainant claims that the aforesaid order is not complied with and therefore, he is before this Court.



5. The learned Principal Government Advocate has today filed a memo and enclosed therewith an official memorandum dated 23.02.2026 issued by the Tahsildar to the concerned official of the Bhoomi Kendra, directing deletion of the entries in column No.11 of the RTC as directed by this Court in the writ petition (referred supra).

6. The learned counsel for the complainant submits that the order is not given effect to.

7. Since the revenue authority has already issued appropriate directions to the Bhoomi Kendra to remove the entries made in Column No.11 of the RTC of Sy.No.66/*/3 of Haladkeri (K) village, we deem it appropriate to close this contempt petition, reserving liberty to the complainant to approach this Court in case the respondents fail to comply with the order.

8. Accordingly, the contempt petition stands ***closed*** but is subject to the observations made in above
