ORAL ORDER

1. Complainant is before this Court seeking for the following reliefs:

a) Initiate contempt proceedings against the accused/respondents for having deliberately, intentionally and willfully disobeying to carry out the direction contend in the order made in W.P.No.203127/2015 (L-PG) dated 15.10.2025 as per Annexure-B and to deal with the accused/respondents in accordance with law and to punish them by imposing the extremely costs.

b) Pass any other or direction deemed fit in the circumstances of the case including cost of the proceedings in the interest of justice and equity.

2. Learned counsel for respondent No.3 has filed a memo enclosing the receipt for having deposited the gratuity amount with interest. Learned counsel for the complainant confirmed the deposit of the



amounts and the calculation made and he submits that he does not wish to press the above contempt petition, since compliance is completed.

3. Placing his submission on record, contempt petition stands ***dismissed***.
