THIS WRIT PETITION IS FILED UNDER ARTICLES 226 AND 227 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA, PRAYING TO ISSUE AN APPROPRIATE ORDER/ DIRECTION/WRIT IN NATURE OF MANDAMUS DIRECTING THE RESPONDENT NO. NO.2 AND 3 TO CONSIDER THE REPRESENTATIONS DATED 15.05.2023 VIDE ANNEXURE-G AND H RESPECTIVELY AND REPRESENTATIONS DATED 31.07.2024 VIDE ANNEXURE-J, DATED 01.08.2024 VIDE ANNEXURE-K AND REPRESENTATION DATED 03.12.2025 VIDE ANNEXURE-L SUBMITTED BY THE PETITIONER. B) ISSUE AN APPROPRIATE ORDER/DIRECTION/WRIT IN NATURE OF MANDAMUS DIRECTING THE RESPONDENT NO.2 AND 3 TO UPDATE THE REVENUE RECORDS PERTAINING TO LAND BEARING SY NO.295/1 MEASURING 5 ACRES 2 GUNTAS FOR THE YEAR 2025-26, SY. NO. 311/1 MEASURING 5 ACRES 13 GUNTAS FOR THE YEAR 2025-26 AND SY. NO.311/2 MEASURING 5 ACRES 16 GUNTAS FOR THE YEAR 2024-25, ALL SITUATED AT VILLAGE NARONA, HOBLI NARONA, TQ. ALAND DIST. KALABURAGI VIDE ANNEXURE-B, C AND D RESPECTIVELY STANDING IN THE NAME OF PETITIONER'S FATHER IN COLUMN NO.9 OF RTC BY RESTORING IN THE NAME OF DARGAH HAZRATH JUNAIDI SAHEB, NANDARGA (SUNNI), NARONA, ALAND TALUK, KALABURAGI DISTRICT.

ORAL ORDER

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner. Sri PS Malipatil, learned counsel is directed to take notice for respondent No.1. Learned Additional Government



Advocate is directed to take notice for respondent Nos.2 and 3.

2. This petition is filed by the petitioner seeking a writ of mandamus for direction to the respondent Nos.2 and 3 to consider the representations dated 15.05.2023 vide Annexure-G and Annexure-H and dated 31.07.2024 vide Annexure-J and dated 01.08.2024 vide Annexure-K and 03.12.2025 vide Annexure-L.

3. It is a case of petitioner that the petitioner's father's name is shown in column Nos.9 and 12 of RTC with regard to land bearing Survey No.295/1 measuring 5 acres 2 guntas for the year 2025-26, Survey No.311/1 measuring 5 acres 13 guntas for the year 2025-26 and 311/೨ measuring 5 acres 16 guntas for the year 2024-25, situated at village Narona, Hobli Narona, Taluk: Aland, District: Kalaburagi. Father of the petitioner died on 13.01.2021, leaving behind the petitioner as his legal heir and successor Muthavalli and Sajjadanashen of Dargah



Hazrath Junaidi Saheb, Nandarga (Sunni). It is stated that after the death of the petitioner's father, the respondent No.1/Waqf board appointed the petitioner as Muthavalli of Dargah Hazrath Junaidi Saheb, Nandarga (Sunni) for a period of 3 years, subject to the condition that the petitioner will take steps to mutate the entries in the revenue records of aforementioned properties.

4. In pursuance of the orders passed by the respondent No.1/Waqf board, respondent Nos.2 and 3 were approached by way of representation requesting to update the revenue records in the name of Dargah Hazrath Junaidi Saheb, Nandarga (Sunni), along with an affidavit declaring that petitioner had no objection for doing so. Petitioner made a representation on 31.07.2024 to respondent No.2 and on 01.08.2024 to respondent No.3 to expedite the matter updating the revenue records standing in the name of petitioner's father to the name of Dargah Hazrath Junaidi Saheb, Nandarga (Sunni). The



representation has not been considered and hence, the petitioner is before this Court.

5. *Per contra*, learned Additional Government Advocate contends that apart from the name of the petitioner being mentioned to an extent of 3 acres and 24 guntas, another person's name is found in the column No.9 of revenue records to an extent of 1 acre and 32 guntas.

6. Be that as it may, when a representation is made by the petitioner, the same will have to be considered in accordance with law. Of course, the authorities are duty bound to issue notice to those persons, whose names are mentioned in the revenue records, notify them, conduct an enquiry and pass suitable orders in accordance with law.

7. Therefore, I pass the following:

ORDER

- i. This petition is ***allowed***.



- ii. A writ of mandamus is issued directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to consider the representations dated 15.05.2023 vide Annexure-G and Annexure-H and dated 31.07.2024 vide Annexure-J and dated 01.08.2024 vide Annexure-K and 03.12.2025 vide Annexure-L and pass suitable orders in accordance to law within a period of 4 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of the order.
- iii. No opinion is expressed by this Court on merits.
