THE 3RD RESPONDENT TO INCORPORATE THE PETITIONER'S NAME IN RTC OF THE LAND LAND SY.NO.85 MEASURING 4 ACRES 38 GUNTAS SITUATED AT VILLAGE MEENKERA, TQ. CHITAGUPPA, DIST. BIDAR AND TO FIX THE BOUNDARIES AS PER ANNEXURE-E.

ORAL ORDER

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Government Advocate, who accepts notice for the respondent.

2. The petitioner is the permanent resident of Mogdal village. The land grant committee of the Tahsildar office, Humnabad granted the land in the name of the petitioner in Survey No.85, measuring 4 acres 38 guntas at Village Meenkera, Taluk Chitaguppa, District Bidar. Accordingly, the Saguvali Chit was issued in the name of petitioner on 31.10.1979. The petitioner is cultivating the said land since 1972. The name of the petitioner is incorporated in the RTC in column Nos.9 and 12.



3. The petitioner made a representation before respondent Nos.2 and 3 to regularise the land and incorporate his name in the RTC by fixing the boundaries of the said land. The said representation has not been considered till today. Hence, the petitioner left with no alternative and efficacious remedy, is before this Court seeking to regularise the land and include his name and issue 'C' form.

4. Learned Additional Government Advocate representing the State, contends that the representation was submitted in physical form. In view of the State machinery having been computerized and digitalized under the E-governance system, any application to be made to the revenue authorities is required to be submitted online through Bhoomi web portal, which has not been done by the petitioner. Therefore, he contends that if such an application is made and upon such receipt, the same would be considered in accordance with law.



5. The submission of learned Additional Government Advocate is placed on record.

6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would file an online application within two weeks from today and he submits that the respondent authorities be directed to consider the same, as the petitioner is cultivating the land since more than 50 years,

7. In view of the above, I pass the following:

ORDER

- (a) The Writ Petition is disposed of.
- (b) The petitioner shall make an online application/representation to respondent No.3.
- (c) On receipt of such application, if any, the respondent shall consider and pass suitable orders within two months from the date of receipt of such application.
