ORAL ORDER

1. The complainant is before this Court seeking for the following reliefs:

"Wherefore, it is most respectfully prayed that, this Hon'ble Court be please to initiate the contempt proceedings against the Accused No.1, Respondent No.4 for their willful, deliberate, wanton disobedience of order the Hon'ble Single Bench Court dated 18-08-2025 passed in Writ Petition No.201511/2025 vide Annexure-A to this Contempt of Court petition, in the interest of justice and equity."

2. By way of order dated 18.08.2025 passed by the learned Single Judge in W.P.No.201511/2025, the fourth respondent therein namely, the Deputy Director of Public Instruction, Bidar, was directed to consider the representation dated 15.04.2025 submitted by the petitioner.



3. A memo along with documents has been filed by the learned Principal Government Advocate enclosing the endorsement issued on 24.10.2025 rejecting the representation of the complainant/petitioner.
4. Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the said order is not in accordance with law. If that be so, it would be for the complainant to challenge the same by filing appropriate proceedings.
5. The order having been issued by the fourth respondent therein and compliance having been completed, the above contempt petition stands closed.
