ORAL ORDER

This contempt petition is filed alleging the non-compliance of an interim order dated 14.01.2026 passed by the learned Single Judge in W.P. No.200262/2026.



2. The complainant No.1 is a Trust, which had established R.V. Higher English Medium School. It appears that a writ petition was filed by them challenging an order dated 31.12.2025 rejecting the renewal and the recognition granted to the complainants. An interim order was passed by the learned Single Judge, permitting the complainant to upload online data of the 10th class students within one week. The respondents in the writ petition were directed to keep open the portal of the petitioners' Institution for uploading the data of the students. The complainants contend that despite the interim order granted by the learned Single Judge and despite the same being informed to the respondents, no steps are taken to enable the complainants to upload the online data of the students.

3. The learned counsel for the complainants reiterated the above submissions.



4. The learned Additional Government Advocate after seeking instructions from the respondents submits that steps are underway to enable the complainants to upload the students' particulars on the online platform. She submits that if 3 days time is given, the respondents would ensure that the whole process is complete.

5. The learned counsel for the complainants do not dispute the above submission.

6. In that view of the matter, this contempt petition is dropped for the time being directing the respondents to ensure compliance of the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

7. However, if the respondents fail to comply with the same, liberty is reserved to the complainant to seek restoration of this contempt petition.



8. Learned Additional Government Advocate is permitted to file memo of appearance for the respondent within two weeks.
