ORAL ORDER

1. The complainant is before this Court, seeking the following reliefs:

"(a) Initiate contempt of proceeding against the accused for disobedience and disrespecting the orders dated 10.12.2025 passed in writ petition No.203775/2025 vide Annexure-E passed by this Hon'ble court in the above writ petition,

And

(b) Pass such order as this Hon'ble court deems fit and proper under the facts and circumstances of the case in the interest of justice and equity."

2. The only grievance of the complainant in the present matter is regarding non-payment of pensionary benefits. One other contempt proceedings having been filed in CCC No.200236/2018 had been



considered, and the matter was disposed of, whereby the submission made by the respondents that the post was not a pensionary post was taken on record. If at all the complainant is aggrieved by the said order, it is for the complainant to challenge the same by filing appropriate proceedings.

3. Reserving such liberty, the contempt petition stands disposed of.
