ORAL ORDER

This petition is filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 by the petitioner/accused for grant of anticipatory bail in C.C.No.9/2026 arising out of Crime No.17/2024 registered by Kembhavi Police Station, Dist: Yadgiri, for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 & 120(B) of IPC, pending on the file of learned Senior Civil Judge and JMFC, at Shorapur.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner so also learned High Court Government Pleader for respondent-State.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced the copy of the order passed by the District and Sessions Judge, Yadgiri, in Criminal Misc.No.307/2024 dated 07.006.2024 and Criminal Misc.No.102/2024 dated 06.03.2024, wherein the learned Sessions Judge has



granted anticipatory bail in both the cases. However, the trial Court has rejected the bail application filed by the present petitioner. It is submitted that the charge sheet is already filed and case is registered in C.C.No.9/2026 on the file of the Senior Civil Judge and JMFC, Shorapur. Accordingly, he prays to allow the petition.

4. *Per contra*, learned High Court Government Pleader opposed to the bail petition.

5. In view of the principle of parity, it is just and proper to allow the petition. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

- (a) The Criminal Petition is ***allowed***.
- (b) The petitioner/accused shall be released on bail in C.C.No.9/2026 arising out of Crime No.17/2024 registered by Kembhavi Police Station, for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 & 120(B) of IPC, subject to the following conditions:



- i. The Petitioner shall execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) with one surety for the likesum to the satisfaction Trial Court.
- ii. The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly threaten or tamper with the prosecution witnesses;
- iii. The petitioner shall not indulge in similar offences in future;
