ORAL ORDER

Learned counsel appearing for the parties have filed
a joint memo of compromise stating that the parties have
amicably settled their dispute.

2. The petitioner and respondent are present
before the Court. The petitioner agreed to pay a total sum
of Rs.6,60,000/- to respondent/complainant including the
amount deposited before the Trial Court i.e.,
Rs.4,60,000/-.

3. Today, the petitioner has paid a sum of
Rs.2,00,000/- to the respondent by way of cash and the
same was received by the respondent and both the parties
have stated that this petition may be disposed of in terms
of joint memo of compromise. Since, the offence involved



in this case is under the provision of Negotiable Instruments Act and compoundable in nature at post conviction stage also. The compromise joint memo is accepted. Accordingly, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

- (a) The petition is ***allowed***.
- (b) The judgment and order dated 07.02.2020 passed in C.C.No.25/2016 by the learned Civil Judge and JMFC, Manvi, which was confirmed in the judgment and order dated 11.03.2024 passed in Criminal Appeal No.10/2020 by the learned II Addl. District and Sessions Judge, Raichur, is hereby set-aside.
- (c) The petitioner/accused is acquitted for the offence punishable under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act.
- (d) Bail bond of the petitioner/accused and that of his sureties shall stand cancelled.
- (e) The fine amount, if any, deposited by the petitioner/accused is ordered to be refunded to him on due identification.
