### **ORAL ORDER**

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the interim order passed by this Court on 08.04.2026 has not been complied by the petitioner.

2. This Court had entertained this writ petition though an office objection was raised with regard to maintainability of the petition, since learned counsel for the petitioner had made a submission before this Court



that the petitioner is ready and willing to deposit a sum of Rs.2,00,000/- before respondent-Bank out of the total amount of Rs.3,60,000/- which is due to be paid by the petitioner. It is under these circumstances, keeping open the office objections, interim order was passed on 08.04.2026.

3. Since the petitioner has not complied the order dated 08.04.2026, I find no good reason to entertain this writ petition. Therefore the office objection regarding maintainability is upheld and the writ petition is ***dismissed*** as not maintainable.
