THIS CRL.P. IS FILED U/S. 439 OF CR.P.C (OLD) U/S 483 OF BNSS (NEW) PRAYING TO GRANT THE REGULAR BAIL TO THE PETITIONER IN SINDHANUR RURAL P.S. IN CRIME NO.57/2026 FOR THE OFFENCES PUNISHABLE U/S 352, 109(1), 115(2), 118(2), 351(2) R/W 3(5) OF BHARATIYA NYAYA SANHITA (BNS), 2023, PENDING ON THE FILE OF III ADDL. DISTRICT AND SESSIONS JUDGE AT RAICHUR, SITTING AT SINDHANUR.

ORAL ORDER

Learned High Court Government Pleader is directed to take notice for the respondent.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned High Court Government Pleader appearing for the respondent/State.

3. The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita for grant of regular bail in Crime No.57/2026 of Sindhanur



Rural Police Station for the offences punishable under Sections 352, 109(1), 115(2), 118(2), 351(2) read with Section 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for short, 'the BNS').

4. On the basis of the complaint filed by Smt. Shantamma, Sindhanur Rural Police have registered the case in Crime No.57/2026 against accused No.1, Veeresh and others for the aforesaid offences. During the course of investigation, the Investigating Officer arrested the accused, produced them before the Court and they were remanded to judicial custody.

5. The bail application filed by the petitioners before III Additional District and Sessions Judge, Raichur Sitting at Sindhanur in Criminal Miscellaneous No.5096/2026 came to be dismissed by order dated 26.03.2026. Hence, the petitioners are before this Court. The Trial Court has observed in the body of the order that the victim sustained grievous injury to his head and was admitted in the hospital and was recently discharged.



6. The petitioners are not required for further investigation. Considering the nature and gravity of offences and previous antecedents of the petitioners, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

The Criminal Petition is allowed.

The petitioners are directed to be enlarged on bail in Crime No.57/2026 registered by Sindhanur Rural Police Station for the offences punishable under Sections 352, 109(1), 115(2), 118(2), 351(2) read with Section 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, pending before the III Additional District and Sessions Judge, Raichur Sitting at Sindhanur, subject to the following conditions:

- (a) Petitioners shall execute personal bond for a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) each with one surety each for the likesum, to the satisfaction of the jurisdictional Court;



- (b) Petitioners shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses or threaten the prosecution witnesses in any manner;
- (c) Petitioners shall appear before the Trial Court on all dates of hearing without fail.
- (d) Petitioners shall not involve themselves in any similar offences in future.
- (e) The Registry is directed to send the copy of this order to the Trial Court.
