ORAL ORDER

In this petition, the petitioner seeks the following reliefs:-

A) issue writ in the nature of mandamus of directing the 4th respondent and 5th respondent to consider the representationS filed by the petitioner vide Annexures-F and G respectively on dated 21.11.2025.

B) Issue writ in nature of mandamus of directing the respondent to regularize the service of the petitioner with all consequential benefits.

C) Pass any order or writ or any direction as deems fit in the circumstances of the case.

02. The limited grievance of the petitioner in the present petition is that the representations at Annexures-F and G dated 21.11.2025 submitted by the petitioner to the respondents No.4 and 5 have not been considered and as



such the petitioner is before this Court by way of the present petition.

03. Learned Additional Government Advocate appearing for respondents No.1 to 4 and learned counsel for respondents No.5 and 6 jointly submits that if reasonable time is granted the respondents No.4 and 5 shall consider the representations submitted by the petitioner at Annexures-F and G dated 21.11.2025 and take appropriate decision / pass appropriate orders in accordance with law.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances and the submission made on behalf of the parties, I deemed it just and appropriate to dispose of this petition directing the respondents No.4 and 5 to address the grievances of the petitioner and take appropriate decision / pass appropriate orders pursuant to the representations at Annexures-F and G dated 21.11.2025 submitted by the petitioner in accordance with law, within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.



05. Subject to the aforesaid directions, petition stands disposed of.
