A WRIT OR ORDER AS UNDER.A) A WRIT OF MANDAMUS DIRECTING THE RESPONDENT AUTHORITY NO.3 ENTER THE NAME OF THE PETITIONER IN THE COMPUTERIZED R O R (PAHANI) AS PER ANNEXURE-D OF LAND SY.NO.147, 4A 38G OF NAGANKERE VILLAGE, TQ. CHITGUPPA AND DIST. BIDAR AND CONTINUE THE NAME OF THE PETITIONER. B) TO PASS ANY SUCH OTHER ORDER OR ORDERS AS THIS HONOURABLE COURT MAY DEEM FIT BASED ON THE FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES.

ORAL ORDER

Petitioner is before this Court under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus directing respondent No.3 to enter the name of the petitioner in the computerized ROR (Pahani) as per Annexure-D of the land bearing Sy.No.147 measuring 4 acres 38 guntas of Nagankere village, Tq. Chitguppa, Dist. Bidar.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Government Advocate, who is directed to take notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 3.



3. It is the case of the petitioner that his father, late Maruti, was granted the aforesaid land bearing Survey No.147 measuring 4 acres 38 guntas and Saguvali Chit was also issued in favour of his father on 20.10.1977 as per Annexure-B. In the revenue records of the aforesaid land, name of petitioner's father was entered. Subsequent to the death of the petitioner's father, it appears that he has submitted a representation as per Annexure-D on 15.10.2018, with a prayer to enter his name in the revenue records of the land in question. Grievance of the petitioner is that till date the said representation is not considered.

4. Per contra, learned Additional Government Advocate submits that if the petitioner files appropriate online application, after paying requisite fee for the purpose of entering his name in the revenue records of the aforesaid land, the same shall be considered after verifying the documents and appropriate orders in



accordance with law shall be passed, if some reasonable time is granted.

5. The said submission is taken on record.

6. Accordingly, the following:

ORDER

- i. Writ petition is ***disposed off***, permitting the petitioner to file a fresh online application in the prescribed format, after paying requisite fee, for the purpose of entering his name in the revenue records of the land in question.
- ii. If such application is filed, the same shall be considered by the respondent No.3-Tahasildar in accordance with law and appropriate order shall be passed as expeditiously as possible, but not later than a period of three months from the date of receipt of such application.
