THIS WRIT PETITION IS FILED UNDER ARTICLES 226 AND 227 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA, PRAYING TO A) ISSUE A WRIT OF MANDAMUS DIRECTING THE RESPONDENT AUTHORITY NO.3 ENTER THE NAME OF THE PETITIONER IN





THE COMPUTERIZED R O R (PAHANI) AS PER ANNEXURE-D OF LAND SY NO. 147, 4 ACRES 38 GUNTAS OF NAGANKERE VILLAGE, TQ. CHITAGUPPA AND DIST. BIDAR AND CONTINUE THE NAME OF THE PETITIONER; B) TO PASS ANY SUCH OTHER ORDER OR ORDERS AS THIS COURT MAY DEEM FIT BASED ON THE FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES IN THE INTEREST OF JUSTICE AND EQUITY.

ORAL ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Government Advocate on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3.

2. Petitioner is before this Court seeking a writ of mandamus directing respondent No.3 to enter her name in the computerized revenue records of the land bearing Sy.No.147 measuring 4 acres 38 guntas situated at Nagankere village, Chittguppa taluk, Bidar district considering her representation at Annexure-D.

3. It is the case of the petitioner that in the year 1977 the aforesaid land was granted to her and a Saguvali Chit dated 20.10.1977 as per Annexure-A was also issued.



It appears that petitioner has submitted a representation on 15.10.2018 vide Annexure-D before the respondent – Tahasildar to enter her name in the revenue records of the land in question. Subsequent to the same, the Tahasildar appears to have forwarded the said application to the Assistant Commissioner seeking clarification and the Assistant Commissioner vide communication at Annexure-E dated 26.12.2019 had called upon the Tahasildar to forward certified copy of the Saguvali Chit for considering the representation of the petitioner. Alleging that her representation at Annexure-D is not considered, the petitioner is before this Court.

4. Learned Additional Government Advocate submits that petitioner has not submitted the copy of Saguvali Chit dated 20.10.1977 under which the aforesaid land has been granted to her. It is under these circumstances, the application of the petitioner is not considered. If the petitioner submits a fresh representation along with the copy of the aforesaid Saguvali Chit and



other supportive document, such representation shall be considered in accordance with law and appropriate orders shall be passed if some reasonable time is granted.

5. The said submission is placed on record.

6. The Writ Petition is ***disposed of*** permitting the petitioner to submit a fresh representation before the respondent – Tahasildar along with the copy of the Saguvali Chit dated 20.10.1977 under which the aforesaid property has been allegedly granted to her and other supportive documents, if any. If such a representation is submitted, it is needless to state that the respondent – Tahasildar shall consider the same in accordance with law and pass appropriate orders as expeditiously as possible but not later than a period of ***four months*** from the date of receipt of such representation along with documents.
