THIS WRIT PETITION IS FILED UNDER ARTICLE 226 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA, PRAYING TO, A) ISSUE A WRIT OF MANDAMUS OR ANY OTHER APPROPRIATE WRIT, ORDER OR DIRECTION DIRECTING RESPONDENTS NO.4 AND /OR 5 TO CONSIDER THE COMPLAINT DATED 07-02-2024 ALONG WITH THE NOTARISED AFFIDAVIT DATED 23-02-2024 AND THE COVERING LETTER DATED 23-02-2024 AT ANNEXURE-A FORTHWITH REGISTER AN FIR AGAINST DILIPKUMAR VAIJINATH DONGRE FOR OFFENCES UNDER SECTIONS 7, 13(1)(B) AND 13(2) OF THE PREVENTION OF CORRUPTION ACT, 1988, AND SUCH OTHER OFFENCES AS ARE DISCLOSED BY THE MATERIAL ON RECORD AND TO CONDUCT A FAIR, INDEPENDENT AND EXPEDITIOUS INVESTIGATION THEREIN; B) DIRECT RESPONDENT NO.1, 4 AND 5 TO REGISTER A SEPARATE FIR AGAINST DILIPKUMAR VAIJINATH DONGRE FOR CRIMINAL INTIMIDATION AND THREAT OFFENCES UNDER SECTION 506 READ WITH SECTION 34 IPC/ SECTION 351 READ WITH SECTION 3(5) BNS FOR THE PHYSICAL THREATS TO THE PETITIONER'S PARENTS ON 29-06-2025 AND THE TELEPHONE INTIMIDATION ON 06-02-2025 AND 07-02-2025 BY CONSIDERING ANNEXURE-C AND ANNEXURE-D AND PROVIDE PROTECTION TO THE PARENTS OF THE PETITIONERS DURING THE PENDENCY OF ENQUIRY; C) DIRECT RESPONDENTS NO.4 AND 5 TO COMPLETE THE INVESTIGATION AND FILE A CHARGE -SHEET BEFORE THE RETIREMENT OF DILIP KUMAR VAIJINATH DONGRE BY 30TH APRIL 2026; D) GRANT ANY OTHER RELIEF OR DIRECTION THAT THIS COURT MAY DEEM FIT AND PROPER IN THE FACTS AND CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE CASE.

ORAL ORDER

Petitioner is before this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking for the following reliefs:

- "A) Issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction directing respondents no.4 and /or 5 to consider the complaint dated 07-02-2024 along with the notarised affidavit dated 23-02-2024 and the covering letter dated 23-02-2024 at Annexure-A forthwith register an FIR against Dilipkumar Vaijinath Dongre for offences under Sections 7, 13(1)(b) and 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, and such other offences AS are disclosed by the material on record and to conduct a fair, independent and expeditious investigation therein;*
- B) Direct respondent no.1, 4 and 5 to register a separate FIR against Dilipkumar Vaijinath Dongre for criminal intimidation and threat offences under section 506 read with section 34 IPC/ section 351 read with Section 3(5) BNS for the physical threats to the petitioner's parents on 29-06-2025 and the telephone intimidation on 06-02-2025 and 07-02-2025 by considering Annexure-C and Annexure-D and provide protection to the parents of the petitioners during the pendency of enquiry;*
- C) Direct respondents no.4 and 5 to complete the investigation and file a charge -sheet before the retirement of Dilip Kumar Vaijinath Dongre by 30th April 2026;*
- D) Grant any other relief or direction that this court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case."*

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Government Advocate on behalf of respondent No.1.



3. Petitioner appears to have submitted a complaint before the Registrar of Karnataka Lokayukta alleging that one Sri Dilipkumar Vaijinath Dongre working as Electrician in BRIMS at Bidar is involved in corruption and he has also mis-utilized the Government funds and thereby caused loss to the institution. Grievance of the petitioner is that pursuant to such a complaint, no FIR has been registered against the said Dilipkumar Vaijinath Dongre for the offences under the provisions of Prevention of Corruption Act and it is under these circumstances he is before this Court seeking for the aforesaid reliefs.

4. Material on record would go to show that complaint has been lodged by the petitioner before the Registrar of Lokayukta alleging that aforesaid Dilipkumar Vaijinath Dongre is involved in corruption and misappropriation of funds belonging to the Government and has caused loss to the institution in which he is working as an Electrician. No complaint has been submitted by the petitioner to the Lokayukta Police who



are the competent authorities to register FIR based on the complaint received by them. Under the circumstances, the petitioner is not entitled for the reliefs sought in the present writ petition.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner, in support of his argument, has placed reliance on the order passed by this Court in W.P.No.200464/2026 disposed of on 05.03.2026. The facts of the said case are totally different and in the said case the complaint was submitted to the police who had not initiated any action. Under the circumstances, this writ petition is liable to be dismissed. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is ***dismissed***. Petitioner is at liberty to approach the concerned authority seeking appropriate relief.
