ORAL ORDER

The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 for grant of bail as accused is in judicial custody in Crime No.27/2026 of Adarsh Nagar Police Station, Dist. Vijayapura, on the file of V-Addl. Civil Judge & JMFC-IV, Vijayapura.

2. I have heard the arguments on both sides.

3. On the basis of the complaint filed by one Sambaji Jadhav, the respondent-Adarsh Nagar Police have registered a case in Crime No.27/2026 against accused Nos.1 to 3 for the offences punishable under Sections 109, 115(2), 118(1), 351(2), 352 read with 3(5) of BNS, 2023. During the course of investigation, the Investigating Officer has arrested the accused on 03.03.2026 and



produced before the Court and accused was remanded to judicial custody. Still the accused is in judicial custody. The bail application was filed before the II-Addl. Dist. & Sessions & Special Judge, Vijayapura, in Crl.Misc.No.272/2026, which came to be dismissed on 07.04.2026. Hence, the petitioner has filed the present petition.

4. On examination of the FIR, it is alleged that, the present petitioner has assaulted to complainant with "khade" on his head. The Trial Court has observed in the order dated 07.04.2026 that the injured already discharged and he is out of danger. The alleged commission of offences are not punishable with death or imprisonment for life. The accused is not required for further investigation. The accused is in judicial custody more than 50 days.

5. Considering the nature and gravity of offences and previous antecedents of the petitioner, I proceed to pass the following:



ORDER

The petition is ***allowed***.

The petitioner/accused No.1 is directed to be enlarged on bail in Crime No.27/2026 of Adarsh Nagar Police Station, Dist. Vijayapura, subject to the following conditions:

- a) Petitioner shall execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety for the likesum, to the satisfaction of the jurisdictional Court;
- b) Petitioner shall appear before the Trial Court regularly on all the dates of hearing without fail;
- c) Petitioner shall not directly or indirectly threaten or tamper with the prosecution witnesses in any manner.
