This writ petition is filed challenging the order of the Karnataka State Administrative Tribunal, Kalaburagi, in Application No.21020/2022 dated 20.04.2023.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been transferred, who was working in the present place of posting from 06.09.2021.

3. Learned HCGP submits that the petitioner has completed 4 years of service and hence, the contention with regard to pre-mature transfer have no application at this stage.

4. In view of the above, this writ petition is closed without prejudice to the rights of the employer to
