ORAL ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned AGA for the respondents and perused the material on record.



2. After arguing the matter for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may be disposed of directing the concerned respondent to consider the representation at Annexure-N dated 29.05.2026 submitted by the petitioner and pass appropriate orders/ take appropriate decision in accordance with law by reserving liberty in favour of the petitioner to take reports to such remedies as available in law including approaching this court subsequently, if the occasion so arises.

3. Per contra learned Additional Government Advocate submits that if reasonable time is granted, the concerned respondent would consider the representation at Annexure-N dated 29.05.2026 and take appropriate decision/ pass appropriate orders in accordance with law.

4. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances and submissions made by both sides, I deem it just and appropriate to dispose of this petition directing the concerned respondent to address the grievances of the petitioner and take appropriate decision/ pass appropriate order pursuant to the representation at Annexure-N dated 29.05.2026 submitted by



the petitioner in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. Further, liberty is also reserved in favour of the petitioner to take reports to such remedies as available in law including approaching this court subsequently, if the occasion so arises.

6. Subject to the aforesaid directions, liberty is reserved in favour of the petitioner and the petition stands disposed of.
