THIS WRIT PETITION IS FILED UNDER ARTICLES 226 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA, PRAYING TO A ISSUE A WRIT OF CERTIORARI OR QUASHING IMPUGNED NOTICE BEARING NO. DATED 18.06.2026 AND 26.06.2026 VIDE ANNEXURE-A AND A1 ISSUED BY THE RESPONDENT NO.3 AS BEING ARBITRARY ILLEGAL AND VIOLATIVE OF ARTICLES 14 AND 21 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

ORAL ORDER

In this petition, the petitioner seeks the following reliefs:

"a) *issue a writ of Certiorari or quashing impugned Notice bearing No. ಸಂ: 12/ಗಡಿಪಾರು/ಎಮ್.ಎ.ಜಿ.2/ಕೆನ/2026 dated 18.06.2026 and 26.06.2026 vide Annexure-A & A1 issued by the Respondent No.3, as being arbitrary, illegal and violative of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India;*



- b) consequently, direct the Respondent No.4 to hold the Externment / Gadiparu from Kalaburagi district to any other district; and*
- c) pass such other or further order(s) as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit, just, and proper in the interest of justice and equity."*

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned AGA for the respondents and perused the material on record.

3. A perusal of the material on record will indicate that the petitioner is aggrieved by the externment notice at Annexure-A dated 18.06.2026 and Annexure-A1 dated 26.06.2026 calling upon the petitioner to appear before respondent No.4 on 02.07.2026.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would appear before respondent No.4 on 02.07.2026 and necessary directions may be issued to respondent No.4 to grant a week's time to the petitioner to submit objections to the impugned notices. Thereafter,



the respondent No.4 may proceed further and pass appropriate orders/take appropriate decision, in accordance with law, in terms of the principles laid down by the Apex Court in the case of ***Deepak vs. State of Maharashtra – 2022 SCC OnLine SC 99***, which has been followed by this Court in the cases of ***Giddappa Vs. Lambu Giddappa Vs. State of Karnataka and others – W.P.No.8182/2023 dated 21.04.2023, Shakeeb @ Mohammed Shakeebullah vs. State of Karnataka & others – W.P.No.14426/2023 dated 28.11.2023*** and ***Sri. Wahid @ Chumati Vs. State of Karnataka and others – W.P.No.202180/2026 dated 11.06.2026***.

5. Per contra, learned AGA submits that if the petitioner appears before respondent No.4 on 02.07.2026 and files objections within a period of one week on 02.07.2026, respondent No.4 shall provide sufficient and reasonable opportunity to the petitioner and hear him and would pass appropriate orders, in accordance with law.



6. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, I deem it just and appropriate to dispose of this petition directing the petitioner to appear before respondent No.4 on 02.07.2026. Upon the petitioner appearing before 02.07.2026, respondent No.4 shall grant a period of one week for the petitioner to submit his reply to the impugned notices and thereafter provide sufficient and reasonable opportunity to the petitioner and pass appropriate orders, after hearing the petitioner and in accordance with law, as per the principles laid down by the Apex Court and this Court in the aforesaid judgments.

7. Subject to the aforesaid observations and directions, the petition stands disposed of.
