ORAL ORDER

1. The complainant is before this Court seeking for the following reliefs:

"Therefore, it is humbly prayed before this Hon'ble Court to initiate contempt proceedings against the respondents for willfully disobeying and disrespecting the orders of this Hon'ble High Court in W.P.No.201415/2022 dt.05.09.2024 Annexure-B to comply the orders passed in W.P.No.201919/2015 dt. 27.11.2020 Annexure-A more particularly at para 15 thereof, in the interest of justice."

2. An affidavit of the Assistant Commissioner, Bidar District, has been filed stating that an order has been passed through E-Office for removing the government restrictions from the RTC of the suit land and initiated RTC correction in Bhoomi software and government restrictions have been removed.



3. Learned counsel for the complainant confirms the same and he seeks permission to withdraw the contempt petition on account of compliance.
