THIS CRIMINAL PETITION IS FILED UNDER SECTION 482 OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, PRAYING TO, A) CALL FOR ENTIRE RECORDS AND QUASH THE FIR, COMPLAINT AND CHARGE SHEET AS PER ANNEXURE-A TO C AND ENTIRE PROCEEDINGS IN WOMEN POLICE STATION, KALABURAGI, IN CRIME NO.39/2023 DATED 04.11.2023, PENDING ON THE FILE OF THE LEARNED II ADDITIONAL CIVIL JUDGE AND JMFC AT KALABURAGI IN CC NO.44/2024, FOR THE OFFENCES PUNISHABLE UNDER SECTIONS 498A, 323, AND 504 R/W SECTION 149 OF IPC., IN THE INTEREST OF JUSTICE AND ETC.

ORAL ORDER

The petitioner No.1 and respondent No.2 are present. They are husband and wife and there is matrimonial dispute between them. They have already settled the matter in Mediation Centre, High Court of Karnataka, Kalaburagi Bench, Kalaburagi and the joint memo of settlement is already filed in this case.

2. On hearing the petitioner No.1 and the respondent No.2, especially the respondent No.2, they admit the terms of settlement and agree that the matter is settled before the mediation.

3. The respondent No.2 acknowledges receipt of Rs.1,25,000/- by way of Demand Draft in terms of the joint memo. The material on record would show that there is matrimonial dispute between the petitioner No.1 and respondent No.2. The case was registered against the petitioners on the complaint of the respondent No.2



for the offences punishable under Sections 498A, 323 and 504 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code and after completion of investigation, the charge sheet is filed for the aforesaid offences. Hence, if matrimonial dispute between the petitioner No.1 and respondent No.2 is settled, the case against the petitioners No.2 to 5 also does not stand for consideration.

4. In the result, I proceed to pass the following:

ORDER

The joint memo of settlement filed by both the petitioner No.1 and the respondent No.2 is accepted.

The Criminal Petition filed by the petitioners is allowed in view of the said joint memo.

Consequently, the FIR, complaint, charge sheet and entire proceedings of the case in CC No.44/2024 arising out of Crime No.39/2023 dated 04.11.2023 of the respondent No.1 Police Station registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498A, 323 and 504



read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code and pending on the file of the learned II Additional Civil Judge and JMFC Court, Kalaburagi is hereby quashed.

In view of disposal of the main petition, interim application, if any, does not survive for consideration and accordingly, stands disposed of.
