ORAL ORDER

Learned counsel for petitioners is not present.

2. Learned HCGP is present through Video conference.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners was not present even on the earlier occasions, when the case was listed on 13.03.2026 and 10.04.2026 and inspite of issuance of notice to respondent No.2, as on today needful has not been done.

4. Petitioners, arraigned as accused Nos.2, 3, 5 and 6 in Crime No.93/2017 of University Police Station, Kalaburgi, have preferred this petition to quash the charge sheet filed against them, pending in C.C.No.6679/2017 on the file of the Court of III Additional Civil Judge and JMFC at Kalaburgi.

5. In this case charge sheet is filed against accused Nos.1 to 6 for the offence punishable under Section 143, 323, 354, 504, 506 read with Section 149 of IPC.

6. Accused No.6 had preferred Crl.P.No.200619/2021 seeking quashing and the said petition was dismissed vide the order dated 02.08.2021. While dismissing the petition, this



Court has observed that it is open for him to file necessary application seeking discharge, if there are no sufficient materials collected by the prosecution. The dismissal of the said petition and the observation made therein hold good to the petitioners as well. Hence, the petition is ***dismissed***.

7. None of the observations made by this Court shall influence the trial Court, while deciding the discharge application, if any, filed by the accused.
