DATED 02.04.2025 AS PER ANNEXURE-F AND DIRECT THE RESPONDENT TO PAY THE BALANCE BILL AMOUNT OF RS 13,30,000/- TO THE PETITIONER IN RESPECT OF CONSTRUCTION OF TOILET (IHHL AND SFC SCHEME WARD NO. 1 TO 23 IN ALAND TOWN INDENT NO. 70931 , 70929) WITHIN TIME FRAME.

THIS PETITION, COMING ON FOR PRELIMINARY HEARING, THIS DAY, ORDER WAS MADE THEREIN AS UNDER:

ORAL ORDER

1. Petitioner is before this Court under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India seeking for the following reliefs:-

a) Issue a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to consider representation of the petitioner dated 2.4.2025 as per Annexure-F and direct the respondents to pay the balance bill amount of Rs.13,30,000/- to the petitioner in respect of Construction of Toilet (IHHL and SFC Scheme Ward No.1 to 23 in Aland Town indent No.70931, 70929), within time frame, in the interest of justice and equity.

b) Issue any writ order or direction as this Hon'ble Court deems fit in the circumstances of the case, in the ends of justice.

2. Heard the learned Counsel for the parties.

3. It is the case of the petitioner who is a Class-I Civil Contractor that bills submitted by him for the work done has not been cleared by the respondent inspite of he submitting



repeated representations. It is under these circumstances, he is before this Court seeking for the aforesaid reliefs.

4. Perusal of the material on record would go to show that petitioner had earlier approached this Court in W.P.No.201805/2024 seeking similar reliefs. The said writ petition was disposed of directing the respondents to consider similar representation of the petitioner dated 22.08.2023 within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of the order.

5. Subsequent to the disposal of W.P.No.201805/2024, the respondents have considered the representation of the petitioner in compliance of the order passed in W.P.No.201805/2024 and has issued an endorsement/communication as per Annexure-C dated 26.03.2025. Perusal of the said communication would go to show that the respondents have mentioned that the petitioner has not submitted any documents to show that he has done the work for the amount which is claimed in his representation.



6. According to the petitioner, subsequently he has given a fresh representation on 02.04.2025 along with necessary documents. However, the petitioner has not produced the copy of the documents which are said to have been produced by him before respondent no.3 along with the representation on 02.04.2025.

7. Learned Counsel for respondent no.3 has stated that petitioner has not produced any documents along with his representation at Annexure-F dated 02.04.2025.

8. If that is so, it is for the petitioner to produce all necessary documents before respondent no.3 in support of his claim made in the representation at Annexure-F dated 02.04.2025. Accordingly, the following order:

9. Writ petition is disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to submit necessary documents before respondent no.3 in support of his claim made in his representation dated 02.04.2025 vide Annexure-F, and if such documents are submitted before respondent no.3, the same shall be considered and appropriate orders shall be passed by



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respondent no.3 on the representation of the petitioner at Annexure-F dated 02.04.2025, as expeditiously as possible, but not later than a period of four months from the date of receipt of the concerned documents.
