Standing Counsel submits that the petitioner was a workman. Terminal benefits payable to the regular establishment employees were not payable to the petitioner. However, the petitioner has been paid Rs.40,000/- erroneously towards Earned Leave Surrender.

Considering the above fact, I find that it is not necessary to prosecute further this Contempt of Court Case. The Contempt of Court Case is closed, granting liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court again or appropriate Forum, if the petitioner finds that further amounts are due.
