Heard Mr. J. Shylla, learned counsel for the petitioner, who has submitted that the petitioner has approached this Court with the instant application under Section 528 BNSS/Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking discharge from a case being Sessions Case No. 21 of 2023 under Sections 307/392/34 IPC pending before the Court of the learned Sessions Judge, East Jaintia Hills District, Khliehriat, wherein he was implicated as one of the accused persons therein.
