Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

By this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of the FIR/proceeding registered vide P.S. Case No.17(8) 2020 with the Mawkyrwat Police Station for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 324/506 read with Section 34 IPC. Quashing is sought on the premise that the parties i.e., the petitioners and the respondent No.4 (original complainant), have amicably settled the dispute.

Issue notice to the respondents returnable on **10th April, 2026**.

Learned Addl.PP waives notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 3. He seeks time to take instructions.

In addition to Court notice, learned counsel for the petitioners to serve the respondent No.4 by private notice/dasti and file an affidavit of service before the next date.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners, in the meantime, till the next date, the proceeding before the trial court shall stand stayed i.e., the proceeding pending before the Court of the District and Sessions Judge at Mawkyrwat, South West Khasi Hills District.
