Issue notice.

Ms. M. Myrchiang, learned counsel vice Dr. N. Mozika, learned DSGI is present and accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents, so no further notice is called for.

The petitioner who has been declared to have overstayed her leave w.e.f. 22.10.2024, and due to her failure to re-join her duties after the said termination of leave, is before this Court praying for directions for the respondents to consider her various representations.
