Mr. K. Deb, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on instructions received, the petitioner is yet to be given any subsistence allowance.

Ms. E.B. Passah, learned counsel for the respondent No. 2, has submitted that from the side of the said respondent all the papers have been released, and there is no impediment for payment of subsistence allowance to the writ petitioner.



In these circumstances, it is expected that the entire process should be completed preferably within a period of 3(three) weeks from today, and the subsistence allowance be released to the petitioner.
