Heard Ms. B. Sun, learned counsel for the petitioner, who has submitted that this application under Section 483 of the BNSS, 2023, has been filed by the mother of the accused person, Shri. Spolkiljune Pariong, who was arrested on the basis of an FIR dated 29.09.2025 lodged by the respondent No. 3/Officer-in-Charge, Nongstoin Police Station, resulting in registration of Nongstoin P.S. Case 66 (09) 2025 under Section (i)(ii)(l)/6 POCSO Act.

Since the matter was on the basis of a report filed by the said respondent No. 3 about teenage pregnancy and the giving birth thereof of the survivor, who admittedly was in the relationship with the accused son of the petitioner, therefore, the relevant provision of the POCSO Act was brought into force.

Before proceeding with the matter, Ms. O.A.I. Bang, learned GA appearing for the State respondent, has submitted that the relatives or guardian



or parents of the survivor may be arrayed as party respondent, so as to get their response as far as the contention of love relationship and consensual sexual intercourse between the survivor and the accused person is concerned.

On consideration of the submission made, at this juncture, this Court is also inclined to the submission of the learned GA.

Accordingly, the mother of the survivor is hereby added as respondent No. 5 to these proceedings.

Petitioner to take steps for issuance of notice upon the respondent No. 5 through the Investigating Officer, who will file the compliance report on the next date.

The State respondent is also directed to produce the case diary on the next date fixed.

List this matter on 19.05.2026.
