Heard learned counsel for the appellant.

2. According to the learned counsel for the appellant, the appellant is suffering from 60% disability. Learned counsel relied on the certificate of disability which is at Annexure-4 at page 35 of the appeal. He submits that the place where the appellant is required to join is a non-family station, and as such, the appellant will not be able to manage his day-to-day activities without the support of his family.

3. Dr. Mozika, learned DSGI states that the appellant be directed to join as presently, the authorities have no such



certificate of disability on their record nor was the same ever brought to their notice in so many years. He submits that after the appellant joins his posting, a medical board will be constituted to examine the appellant to verify his disability.

4. Accordingly, the appellant to report to Miao in Arunachal Pradesh. The respondent authority to constitute a medical board, at the earliest and in any event within three weeks from today. The report of the medical board be placed before us on the next date, after which appropriate orders will be passed.

5. Stand over to **24<sup>th</sup> June, 2026** to enable the medical board to place the report before us with respect to the appellant's disability.
