Heard Ms. I.S. Kharumnuid, learned counsel for the petitioner, who has submitted that among other grounds, the prayer made in this application for grant of bail, is also on the ground of medical urgency, inasmuch as, it has been reliably learnt that the accused person in question is suffering from “Left Mid Uretic with Right Pelvi-Uretic Junction Calculus (PUJ), Obstructive Uropathy Hydroureteronephrosis and Renal failure (Serum creatinine was 6.2 mg/dl), On 18/04/2026, Bilateral (PCN) percutaneous Nephrostomy was done and on 29/04/2026, Left ureteroscopic Lithotripsy with Bilateral (PCNL) percutaneous Nephrolithotomy & Bilateral DJ Stenting was done under SA (Spinal Anesthesia) & GA (General Anesthesia)”, and requires immediate medical attention.

The learned counsel also submits that, admittedly, the accused/patient has been referred to NEIGRIHMS, Shillong and was thereafter discharged, but lately, in fact, as recent as yesterday, his condition



has developed complicacy, and therefore, he requires immediate medical treatment.

The learned counsel has further submitted that, it is also reliably learnt that the concerned surgeon at NEIGRIHMS is not available, as such, prayer is made herein that the accused may be enlarged on bail, to allow the petitioner and his relatives to have him referred to any private medical facility/hospital.

At this juncture, Mr. N.D. Chullai, learned AAG assisted by Mr. E.R. Chyne, learned GA appearing for the State respondent has submitted that the medical report or medical status of the accused/patient may be called for from the prison authorities or the doctor concerned, so as to enable this Court to gauge the condition of the said accused/patient, and to pass necessary orders.

Accordingly, as prayed for, the prison authorities including the doctor concerned, is directed to file the latest medical status report as far as the medical condition of the accused/patient is concerned.

Let copy of this order be issued upon the Superintendent, District Prisons and Correctional Home, West Jaintia Hills District, Jowai for compliance.

The learned AAG has also assured that efforts will be taken from his end to ensure that the said report is placed before this Court on the next date.

As prayed for, list this matter for further hearing tomorrow i.e. 12.06.2026.
