1. Heard Ms. B.S.Goyal, learned counsel for the petitioner.
2. Issue notice.
3. Dr. N.Mozika, learned DSGI assisted by Ms. C.Jala, learned counsel is present and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No. 1-5, as such, no further notice is required on these respondents.
4. Notice to issue to the respondents No. 6, 7 & 8 within three days.
5. The grievance of the writ petitioner who is stated to be a tenderer for supply of fresh vegetables and fresh non-vegetarian items to the respondents



is that though the petitioner and the respondent No. 6 were declared to be technically qualified for supply of the items, notwithstanding the fact that respondent No. 6 is L1, as per the learned counsel, the technical criteria was not met by the respondent No. 6 due to lack of experience. She therefore, prays that in the interim, the tender may not be given effect to.

6. Dr. N.Mozika, learned DSGI assisted by Ms. C.Jala, learned counsel for the respondents No. 1-5, however, has produced a set of instructions/communication dated 01-06-2026, and submits that as per the records and information received, the respondent No. 6 is qualified on both counts, technical and financial, inasmuch as, he is L1 and is also engaged in supply of fresh rations. He therefore, submits that no interim order is called for at this stage.

7. On hearing the learned counsel for the parties, and on perusal of the materials as placed, it is directed that the instructions be placed on affidavit within one week.

8. List this matter on 12-06-2026.
