Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. By this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of the FIR and consequently, the proceeding pending against them (original accused) in the Court of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Shillong. Quashing is sought on the premise that the parties i.e, the petitioners and the respondent Nos. 2 to 4 have amicably settled the dispute.

3. In view of the aforesaid, issue notice to the respondents returnable on **15th July, 2026**.

4. Learned Additional PP waives notice on behalf of the respondent No. 1 and seeks time to take instruction. The



concerned Officer well versed with the facts of the case to remain present on the next date. Instructions to be taken whether apart from the respondent Nos. 2 to 4, there are any other persons who were cheated and whose statements have been recorded under Section 161 Cr.P.C. and that whether said statements are there in the charge-sheet. Learned Addl PP to go through the charge-sheet so as to assist the Court whether apart from the respondent No. 2 to 4 there were any other persons who were cheated.

5. In addition to Court notice, learned counsel for the petitioners to serve the respondent Nos. 2 to 4 by private/dasti notice and file affidavit of service before the next date.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, in the meantime, till the next date, the trial court shall not proceed with the trial.
