By this petition, the petitioners i.e., the petitioner No. 1 (accused) and the petitioner No. 2 (prosecutrix) seek quashing of the FIR registered with Rynjah Police Station and consequently, the proceeding pending before the learned Special Judge, POCSO, East Khasi Hills District, Shillong. Quashing is sought by consent of the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at the time of the incident, the petitioner No. 1 was aged 19 years and the petitioner No. 2 was 16 years old. She further submits that the physical relationship between the petitioners was consensual and that only when she went for medical check-up during pregnancy that the doctors informed the same to the



police pursuant to which, the FIR was lodged. She further submits that the parties have a child aged 3½ years from the said relationship. She further states that today, the petitioner No. 1 is 22 years and the petitioner No. 2 is 20 years of age.

3. Considering the aforesaid, the parties i.e., the petitioners are directed to appear before the Secretary, High Court Legal Committee within two weeks to enable the Secretary to submit her report as to whether the consent given by the petitioner No. 2 is an informed consent; whether she and her child have received any benefits under any of the Schemes, either of the State or Central Government, etc. The Secretary to submit her report in sealed envelope on the next date.

4. Stand over to **6th July, 2026**.

5. In the meantime, till the next date, the proceeding before the Special Judge POCSO, East Khasi Hills, Shillong i.e., Special POCSO Case No. 75 of 2022, shall stand stayed.
