2. Perused the petition. From a perusal of the petition, it appears that the petitioners are seeking quashing of the FIR registered with the Women Police Station Khliehriat, East Jaintia Hills, at the behest of the respondent No. 2 against the petitioner No. 1, for the alleged offences punishable under Section 376 and 506 of the IPC and Section 5(l) read with Section 6 of the POCSO Act, 2012.

3. Quashing is sought on the premise that the relationship between the petitioners i.e., the petitioner No. 1(accused) and



the petitioner No. 2 (survivor) was consensual and that they are married to each other and have two children aged, 6 and 2 years.

4. Issue notice to the respondents returnable by **23rd July, 2026.**

5. Learned AAG waives notice on behalf of the respondent No. 1. He seeks time to take instructions. A report from the concerned Police Station to be submitted on the next date with respect to whether what is stated in the petition by the petitioners is true and correct.

6. In addition to Court notice, learned counsel for the petitioners to serve the respondent No. 2 by private/dasti notice and file affidavit of service before the next date.

7. Having perused the papers, in the meantime, till the next date, the proceeding before the trial court shall stand stayed.

After the aforesaid order was passed at 11.20 a.m., learned counsel for the petitioners mentioned the petition. She



states that yesterday afternoon, a non-bailable warrant was issued against the accused. If what is disclosed by the learned counsel for the petitioners is true, the same is stayed till the next date.
