Heard Mr. Th.R. Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner who has submitted that this application has been filed with a prayer for grant of anticipatory bail on the petitioner being implicated in connection with Shella P.S. Case No. 24 of 2026 under Section 74/126(2)/137(2)/62 of the BNS, 2023. It is the submission of the learned counsel that since the petitioner is apprehending arrest as such, this Court is approached for necessary direction to be issued in this regard.

The learned counsel has further admitted that the petitioner has been issued with a notice under Section 35(3) of the BNSS but could not appear before the concerned Officer on the date fixed due to person difficulties.

Mr. R. Gurung, learned GA for the State respondent has submitted that the language of Section 35(2) is very clear and if the noticee could not appear before the IO as directed, he could have made a prayer for fixing of another date which was not done so.



This Court has considered the submission made and at this stage it is felt necessary that the case diary and latest status report be produced which is hereby directed to be done so.

Let the case diary and latest status report be filed on or within 23.07.2026.

In the meantime, as prayed for, the petitioner is granted interim bail. He is further at liberty to approach the IO and to cooperate with the investigation.
