Mr. Pandey, learned GA appearing for the appellant submits at the time of opening the appeal that a very vital document is sought to be introduced by his client before this Court having a substantial bearing on the case. He says that the document would show that in fact there was not any gift of the subject land by the respondents to the appellant but that consideration passed for the transfer. Therefore, there was no basis for the respondents to claim employment in lieu of gratis transfer of land.

To enable this Court to do complete justice between the parties, we grant leave under Order 41 Rule 27 of the Civil Procedure Code to the appellant to bring on record this document by filing a supplementary paper-book by 4th July, 2025. Copies of the supplementary paper-book

should be served upon Advocate-on-Record for the respondents by the above date.
