[1] Heard Ms. Guni, learned counsel for the petitioner.

[2] By the present petition under Section 482 of BNSS, the petitioner is praying for anticipatory bail along with prayer for interim bail in FIR No. 29(10)2025 WPS-IW U/S 69 BNS added, 376, 417 IPC.

[3] The allegation in the FIR is that the petitioner and complainant have physical relationships on promise to marry and the petitioner has withdrawn from the assurance given by him to the complainant. The petitioner earlier approached the Ld. Additional Sessions Judge (FTC), Manipur East by way of Cril. Misc. (AB) No. 200 of 2025 and the interim order was granted on 14.10.2025 and vide order dated 25.11.2025, the bail application was rejected and the interim order was vacated on the ground that custodial interrogation will be required.

[4] Even though the complainant appeared before the Ld. Additional Sessions Judge (FTC), she has not made a party in the present application. In the circumstances, this Court exercising suo moto power impleads the complainant as respondent No. 2.

[5] Petitioner is directed to file amended memo of parties. It is also submitted that the petitioner is an official in the Department of Horticulture and Soil Conservation and the complainant is also an employee of the same department.

[6] Copy of the FIR and complaint are not on record. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that she has not received a copy of the same.

[7] In the circumstances, Mr. H. Samarjit, learned PP is directed to place on record a copy of the FIR and complaint lodged by the complainant.

[8] Issue notice.

[9] Mr. W. Niranjit, learned Dy. G.A. accepts notice on behalf respondent No. 1 and Mrs. G. Pushpa, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of newly impleaded respondent No. 2/complainant.

[10] List this case before the appropriate bench on 13.01.2026. No coercive action till 13.01.2026.
