[1] Heard Mr. Kh. Tarunkumar, learned senior counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Th. Sukumar, learned GA for the State respondents.

[2] Vide order dated 16.02.2019 issued by Under Secretary, Government of Manipur appointed the petitioner in the post of Labour Inspector with immediate effect.

[3] The petitioner and other were recommended by DPC dated 28.09.1998 and one of the recomendee was later on appointed by creating a supernumerary during ban period. It is stated that the vacancy arose on 20.02.1999 much before the imposition of ban on direct recruitment by order dated 06.11.1999.

[4] Since the petitioner was appointed only in the year 2019, he lost 20(twenty) years of service. This Court proposed to dispose of the present writ petition on the proposition that appointment of the petitioner as Labour Inspector be effective from 20.02.1999(date of vacancy) without any

financial benefits so as to enable him to enjoy the pensionary and other benefits.

[5] Mr. Kh. Tarunkumar, learned senior counsel for the petitioner as well as Mr. Th. Sukumar, learned GA for the State respondents seeks two weeks' time for taking instruction in this regard.
