[1] Heard Mr. M. Rendy, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Shyam Sharma, learned G.A. for the State respondent.

[2] The petitioner approached this Court for directing the State respondent to release the rank honorarium of pay attached to the post of Company Commander.

[3] In para 9 of the counter affidavit filed by the State respondent, it is stated that there is no official record with respect to Home Guard No. 21-021 and hence, the petitioner is not eligible for any honorarium.

[4] Mr. M. Rendy, learned counsel for the petitioner, draws the attention of this Court to Annexure-A/5 which is order dated 03.03.2005 whereby the petitioner has been promoted as Company Commander, Home Guards with HG. No. 22021 and the statement in

para 9 of the counter affidavit is not related with the petitioner. Hence the petitioner is entitled to the rank honorarium.

[5] Mr. Shyam Sharma, learned G.A., prays for two weeks' time to clarify as to whether there is any official record with respect to HG. No. 22021 and the same may be filed by way of additional affidavit with an advance copy to the other side.
