[1] Heard Mr. N. Jotendro, learned Sr. counsel assisted by Md. Abdul Baqee Khan, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

[2] Issue notice, returnable within 2(two) weeks'.

[3] Mr. Shyam Sharma, learned GA entered appearance and accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents, hence no formal notice is called for.

[4] The simple case of the petitioner is that without giving him any notice or without furnishing the Article of charges framed against him and all the supporting documents, the respondents are contemplating to initiate a departmental enquiry against him. On coming to know about it the petitioner has approached the authority more particularly the Superintendent of Police, Imphal West (Respondent no. 3) by submitting two representations dated 09.03.2026 requesting the respondent no. 3 for furnishing all the

relevant documents in connection with the said departmental enquiry initiated against the petitioner so that he can defend himself in connection with the enquiry initiated against him. The learned Sr. counsel submitted that the present writ petition can be disposed of directing the respondents to furnish all the documents in connection with the departmental enquiry initiated against the petitioner within a stipulated period so as to enable the petitioner to defend himself effectively and meaningfully.

[5] The learned Sr. counsel further submitted that pending furnishing of the said documents to the petitioner, a direction be issued to the respondents not to proceed further with the said departmental enquiry.

[6] Mr. Shyam Sharma, learned GA appearing for the respondents submitted that he may be given a week time to get instructions from the authorities and revert back to this Court.

[7] In view of the submission made above, list this case again on 26.03.2026.

[8] It is made clear that till the next date, no adverse action should be taken up against the petitioner in connection with the said departmental enquiry.

[9] A copy of this order be furnished to all the counsel appearing for the parties through their Whatsapp/Email for doing the needful.
