Mr. S. Gunabanta, learned counsel appeared for the petitioner in El. Petn. No. 8 of 2022 and Mr. N. Kumarjit, learned senior counsel assisted by Mr. N. Zequeson, learned counsel appeared for the respondent No. 1.

The record of these cases have been put up before this court with a report of the appointed Advocate Commissioner. In the said report, it has been mentioned, inter alia, that after the examination and cross-examination of the PWs had been over, the counsel for the petitioner made a submission that more official witnesses are required to be examined, however, as no official witnesses names were furnished, the matter has been put up before this court.

When the matter is taken up today, Mr. S. Gunabanta, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that he has not made any submission for further examination of the official witnesses and that he wants to close the examination of PWs and that the examination of DWs can be started.

Mr. N. Kumarjit, learned senior counsel appearing for the respondents submitted that the respondents may be permitted to produce the DWs and start their examination just after the opening of the Winter Vacation.

Mr. S. Gunabanta, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that he has no objection.

In view of the submission made by the learned counsel appearing for the parties, registry is directed to place the record of these cases before the appointed Advocate Commissioner for fixing a date for examination of the DWs.
